

Manriders



People are at greater risk of harm when they are lifted by machinery. The increased risks for lifting equipment require greater levels of safety in their selection and use.

- All plant / equipment used for lifting persons must be subject to a 6 monthly thorough inspection
- Manriders must have a unique identifying number and SWL marked.
- Manriders must be checked before every use
- All lifts must be planned by an AP and the lifting team must be competent for their roles.
- Persons in the manrider must wear the specified PPE and fall restraint.
- Tools and equipment in the manrider should be tethered.
- Persons should not attempt to work outside of the manrider.
- Persons should not attempt to enter or leave the manrider at any point when it is suspended.
- Communication between the lifting team and the occupants of the manrider must be defined and maintained.
