

SAFETY ALERT

Date: 11th March 2021

Alert Type: Injury

Detail of Event

On the 11th March 2021, the IP had been tasked with cleaning 1300mm casings with a jet wash prior to their removal from the site. During the cleaning the IP sustained injury to the 2 small toes on his right foot. The injury sustained was a result of the jet wash penetrating the IP's boot as it passed over.

The IP has received several stitches to the wound in his right foot and cannot currently walk without the aid of crutches.

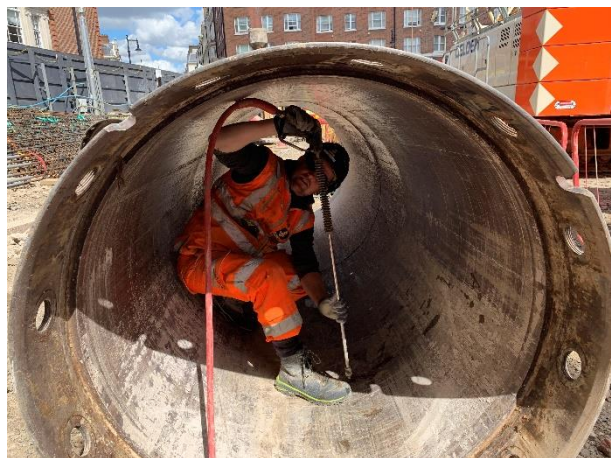


Damage sustained to the IP's boot from the jet wash.

The jet wash used had been a standard jet wash use don all Bauer sites. The jet wash operates at a maximum of 3000psi.

Root Cause:

IP had positioned himself within the casing to complete the cleaning. Due to the size of casing the work area had been restrictive which reduces the amount of control the IP had on the jet wash lance.



Corrective Actions:

All Bauer operatives informed that there is to be no entry into the casings at any time to conduct cleaning.

Additional lances to be ordered to provide a greater reach when cleaning sections of casing.
