ENTRY PROCESS

Entries will be shortlisted by an expert judging panel who will review all applications in detail before making a final decision. The Awards are free to enter and may be entered by FPS Members and Associate Members only.

THE AWARDS

SAFETY INNOVATION AWARD

Judges will be looking for a standout entry where a company can showcase a recent innovation, initiative or dynamic approach that has considerably improved the safety of their workforce or the industry.

Entries should describe the nature of the safety innovation, how it has improved workforce or industry safety practice and how it integrates into the company's safety culture.

SUSTAINABILITY AWARD

The Sustainability Award recognises excellence in carbon reduction and environmental initiatives.

The judges will be looking for an innovative or cutting-edge approach to driving sustainability on a recent ground engineering project and the benefits achieved.

Entries should outline the nature of the initiative, the environmental benefits of enforcing the initiative and the measurable benefits of applying the method.

SITE APPRENTICE AWARD

New for 2023, the Site Apprentice Award will recognise an individual with up to five years industry experience who has shown exceptional ability in their role as an apprentice working on site.

Nominees should be able to demonstrate a strong commitment to personal learning and development, an excellent approach to teamwork and supporting others, and a passion for the ground engineering industry.

LIFETIME ACHEIVEMENT AWARD

The Lifetime Achievement Award will be presented to an inspirational and influential individual who has dedicated a large proportion of their life to the ground engineering sector and has made a significant contribution to the piling industry.

Members are invited to nominate a candidate from either inside or outside of the FPS and provide a brief explanation of why the person should be considered for this prestigious accolade.

CHAIR'S AWARD

This award will be judged by the Executive Committee and will recognise an FPS Member employee who has made a significant personal contribution to the aims and interests of the Federation of Piling Specialists.

Company Managing Directors are invited to nominate a candidate within their companies and provide a brief explanation of why the person should be considered for this accolade.
